I. Applicant requirements

For applications to be considered, candidates must satisfy the following requirements:

- ▶ Hold the title of Doctor (PhD), awarded since 1 January 2005
- ▶ Have at least one publication as first author in an international peer reviewed journal

The following persons are not eligible for this program:

- ▶ Researchers who have undertaken their doctoral thesis at the CNIC
- ▶ Researchers who have been contracted at the CNIC for more than one year

II. General conditions

- ▶ A maximum of three postdoctoral contracts will be awarded in the current round of applications
- ▶ Successful candidates will be contracted with a gross annual salary range is 34,929 - 39,294 euros
- ▶ The employment contract will be for an initial period of two years. After a positive evaluation by the CNIC Research Committee the contract will be extendible for another year
- ▶ The program provides additional funds for visits of up to a maximum of six months per researcher to research centers abroad

III. Application procedures and required documentation

- ▶ Candidates interested in participating in this program should, in the first instance, send an e-mail to the Research Scientist/s in the laboratory/ies that they would like to join
- ▶ Candidates accepted by a Research Scientist must present the required documentation according to the procedure specified at the CNIC website: <http://www.cnic.es>
- ▶ The closing date for applications for the current round of applications is 27 February 2009

IV. Evaluation and selection of candidates

- ▶ Candidates will be selected on the basis of merit, according to principals of objectivity and open competition
- ▶ The submitted documentation will be evaluated by the CNIC Research Committee. Should the committee consider it necessary, external experts may be consulted as part of the evaluation procedure on an *ad hoc* basis. The final selection must be approved by the Executive Committee of the CNIC

V. Award





- ▶ The result of the present round of applications will be announced in March 2009 and published on the CNIC website
