- **Date of publication:** 18 January 2012
- **Deadline:** 18 April 2012 at 17:00 Brussels local time
- **Indicative budget:** €1 million of the 2012 budget (The final budget awarded to this call, following the evaluation of the projects, may vary up to 10% of the total value of this call.)

- **Eligibility conditions:**
 - The general eligibility criteria are set out in Annex 2 to this work programme, and in the guide for applicants. Please note that the completeness criterion also includes that part B of the proposal shall be readable, accessible and printable.
- **Additional eligibility criteria**
 - Only members of the EURAXESS Services Network (committed by the signature of the 'Declaration of Commitment') are eligible to participate in this call.
 - Consortia have to include at least three independent legal entities from three different Member States or associated countries.
 - For further details concerning these conditions you must refer to the core text of the work programme.
- **Evaluation procedure:**
 - The evaluation criteria (including weights and thresholds) and sub-criteria together with the eligibility, selection and award criteria, for the different funding actions are set out in Annex 2 to this work programme.
 - Proposal page limits: Applicants must ensure that proposals conform to the page limits and layout given in the Guide for Applicants, and in the proposal part B template available through the EPSS. The experts will be instructed to disregard any pages exceeding these limits.

- The minimum font size allowed is 11 points. The page size is A4, and all margins (top, bottom, left and right) should be at least 15 mm (not including any footers or headers).
 - A single-stage submission and evaluation procedure will be used following a single proposal submission.
 - Proposals will not be evaluated anonymously.
 - Proposals may be evaluated remotely.
 - The procedure for prioritising proposals with equal scores is described in Annex 2 to this work programme.
 - Proposals will be evaluated in a single multi-disciplinary panel and there will be a single ranked list.
- **Indicative evaluation and contractual timetable:**
 - Evaluation results are estimated to be available within 2 months following the deadline for submission.
 - Grant agreement signature: expected from within 6 months after the deadline for submission.

- **Consortia agreements:**

Participants in actions resulting from this call are NOT required to conclude a consortium agreement.

- **Additional information:**

The Commission will finance up to five proposals under this call. Grant agreements shall be awarded for up to 24 months.

- **Forms of grants and maximum reimbursement rates:**

The forms of grants and maximum reimbursement rates which will be offered are specified in Annex 3 to this work programme.
